

NOBC Meeting Saturday, February 20, 2010

- The **NOBC 2 Person Time Trial** will be held on Sunday, March 21. For this event we have the following needs:
 - Sponsorship – Any sponsorship would be appreciated to help defray police costs, which are about \$500.
 - Help at the event:

 - Other possible courses mentioned:
 - The Covington course has not been repaved, to the best of our knowledge, but would be our first option and we do expect to return there if the streets are ever repaved. The condition of the streets resulted in two broken plate glass windows and one truck window. We do not need that added cost.
 - Around the Superdome. Jay Batt stopped by campaigning and said to call him after the election regarding this option. David Simon is working on an e-mail to Doug Thornton, who Jay recommended contacting, also.
 - Jay Scheib had mentioned Mandeville being interested in hosting a crit. Mark to contact Jay for more information.
 - David Simon to check on what looks to be a new home construction site in Ormond.
 - At the west end of the Convention center, near Blaine Kern's Mardi Gras world.
 - A couple of Westbank sites as well.
 - If anyone knows of an additional site, please let Randy or Mark know.
 - Sponsorship for the 3 stages of the Tour de Louisiane are needed to help cover police costs.
