

MARCH 25-26: TOUR DE LOUISIANA, a B.A.R., A.B.L. of A. sanctioned race

"New Orleans is French-Spanish, and she is African-Voodoo. She's a banana city. A country town. Her soul radiates with Southern beauty. She's a Mississippi Queen with bayous. But most important she's New Orleans. The crescent city is not intended to become a reproduction of the Great American Dream." The TOUR DE LOUISIANA is not intended to be a reproduction of other Am. races. The initial stage, a 4 mi. TT, will take place on the Lakefront along the lip of serene Lake Pontchartrain; the following event will be an 85 mi. road race through undulating hills in the pine dotted Covington area; finally, the third stage will occur Sunday in sugar cane and bayou country--Donaldsville, La. on a criterium course which contains 5 sharp corners plus 2 sweeping turns.

The winner of the TOUR DE LOUISIANA will be presented with the Governor's Trophy (\$300) by the Governor of La. Edwin Edwards. The perpetual trophy will be given to the rider who wins the TOUR DE LOUISIANA 3 times. Remember the tour is a B.A.R. event. An awards banquet will follow the tour. We hope to see you down here!
