This year the **Tour de Louisiana** celebrates its fifty-second year as a club-promoted stage race. As far as we know, it's the oldest such race in the country. This is a race that is run entirely by and for competitive cyclists, most of whom would really rather be riding in it. The promoter, officials, judges and assistants are primarily active cyclists who donate their time and energy toward running a bicycle race that they, as bicycle racers, can be proud of. The Tour is promoted by the **New Orleans Bicycle Club**, and many of its members contribute to its success. We generally consider "success" to be breaking even on expenses, not sending anyone to the hospital, and not taking up so much time that we have to miss any other area races.

We would like to thank the Orleans Levee District Police, the St. Bernard Parish Sheriff's Office, and all of our sponsors.

We would also like to thank all of the members of the New Orleans Bicycle Club and Louisiana/Mississippi bicycle racing community who helped out when needed. REGISTRATION

SATURDAY RACE-DAY REGISTRATION AND NUMBER PICKUP

Race day registration and number pick-up opens at 7:00 a.m. on Saturday and closes 30 minutes prior to each race, Lakeshore Drive east of Franklin Avenue. **Parking inside the course will not be available after 7:30.** Parking is available in the parking lot at Lakeshore Drive and Elysian Fields Avenue near 2220

Lakeshore Dr. **Race-day registrations are \$10 additional.** Any riders racing only the time trial must pick up numbers prior to the start of the last circuit race so that the start list can be generated.

SUNDAY RACE DAY REGISTRATION AND NUMBER PICKUP

Sunday race day registration and number pick-up opens at 7:00 am and closes 30 minutes prior to each race. Sidney Torres Park, 3400 Dr. Meraux Blvd., Chalmette, LA. **Race-day registrations are \$10 additional.**

RACE NUMBERS

The **large number** should be placed on the *side* of the lower back, just above the pockets (if any), turned so that the numbers are upright when the rider is horizontal. The other number goes on the back so it is visible from behind (required for Road Race and Criterium only). Judging for all races will be from the right side, so side numbers go on the **RIGHT**.



RULES AND REGULATIONS

FINAL STANDINGS IN ALL CLASSES WILL BE DETERMINED BY TOTAL POINTS (see below). Ties on GC resolved by finish order on the final stage. Special rules for each stage can be found below. GC riders must start each stage to be eligible for prizes. Riders unable to finish a stage may start the next stage.

POINTS SCHEDULE

STAGE PLACINGS

Circuit Race and Criterium: The top **15 finishers** in the Circuit Race and Criterium stages will be awarded POINTS as follows: 25, 20, 16, 14, 12, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1 point.

Time Trial: The top **10 finishers** in the Time Trial stage will be awarded POINTS as follows: 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1 point.

HOT SPOTS

There will be a single HOT SPOT for each class in the Circuit Race and in the Criterium. Hot Spots will be at the approximate mid-point of each race. Hot spot time bonuses will be awarded for the **first three places** (all classes) as follows: 5, 3, and 2 points.

TRAFFIC CONTROL AND PARKING

Courses will be closed to traffic, however there is always the possibility of a car, non-race bicycle, or pedestrian getting onto the course so riders must always exercise caution. Special course instructions appear below for each event.

Circuit Race & Time Trial Parking: Parking is available inside the course at the start/finish until 7:30 am. Cars parked there will not be allowed to exit until the end of the Cat. 1/2/3 race. Alternate parking that will be open all day is available in the parking lot at Lakeshore Drive and Elysian Fields Avenue near 2220 Lakeshore Dr. Dr. Special care must be taken by riders parked at Elysian Fields when transiting from the parking lot to the start/finish since they will be on the course.

Criterium Parking: Parking is available in the Civic Center parking lot, 8245 W Judge Perez Dr, Chalmette, LA 70043.

STAGE 1 Lakeshore Circuit Race

PARKING

Parking inside the course will close at 7:30 am. Vehicles parked inside the course may not exit until the final circuit race is completed.

CIRCUIT RACE RULES

1. There are no free laps in the circuit race. Wheel changes etc. are allowable in the area of the start/finish.
2. **Lapped riders** finish on the same lap as the leader.
3. **FEEDING** is not allowed anywhere on the course.
4. **COURSE:** Check the course map! Riders are responsible for staying on the course.
5. **Riders registered for the full Stage Race who are unable to finish the Circuit Race will be allowed to compete in remaining stages** but will not be scored for GC or time bonuses. ALL registered riders are eligible to compete in the Time Trial.
6. Riders must MAINTAIN LANE POSITIONS in the final 200 meters for a sprint finish.
7. CROSSING THE CENTER LINE of the road is prohibited.

CIRCUIT RACE COURSE**SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS**

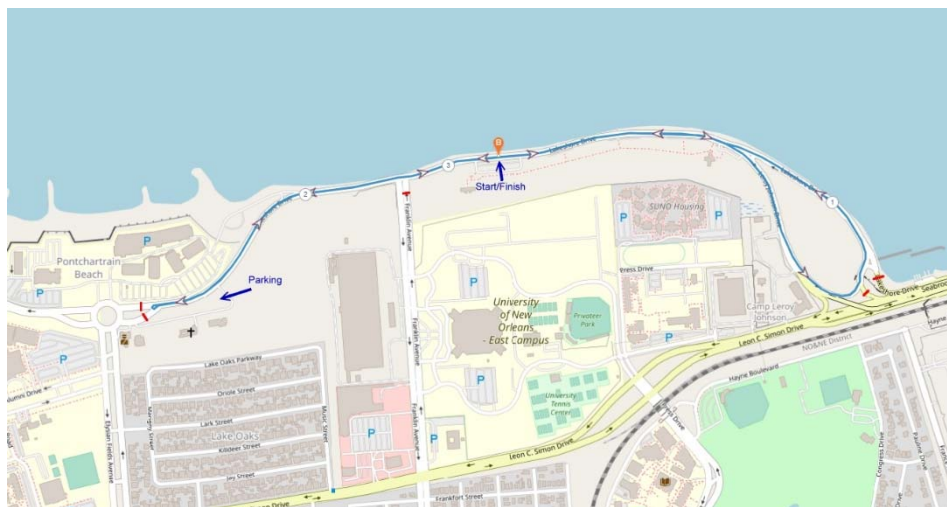
1. The circuit race is essentially an out-and back 3.1 mile course with a loop on the east end and a U-turn on the west end that crosses the lakefront levee three times per lap.
2. The road surface is generally good but includes a few places that require special attention. Entering the Seabrook loop at the east end of the course there is a lengthwise seam in the concrete that should be avoided. Mid-way through the loop the course crosses the metal floodgate track and shortly thereafter a low buckle across the road. Both hands on the bars there!
3. Just before the U-turn there is a buckle in the concrete across the road that is a significant bump. The road surface through the U-turn is a little rough and the turn can be tight if speeds are high, so caution is required there.
4. There is often some accumulated sand from the lake up against the curb, so don't ride there!

HOT SPOT

There will be a time bonus Hot Spot at the end of the first lap of each race for *First-Third places only* worth 5, 3 and 2 POINTS respectively.

CIRCUIT RACE RESULTS

Results of the Road Race and the **start list for the Time Trial** will be posted to lambra.org and at registration table as soon as they are finalized. Protests of stage and GC placings are acceptable up until the start of the next stage.

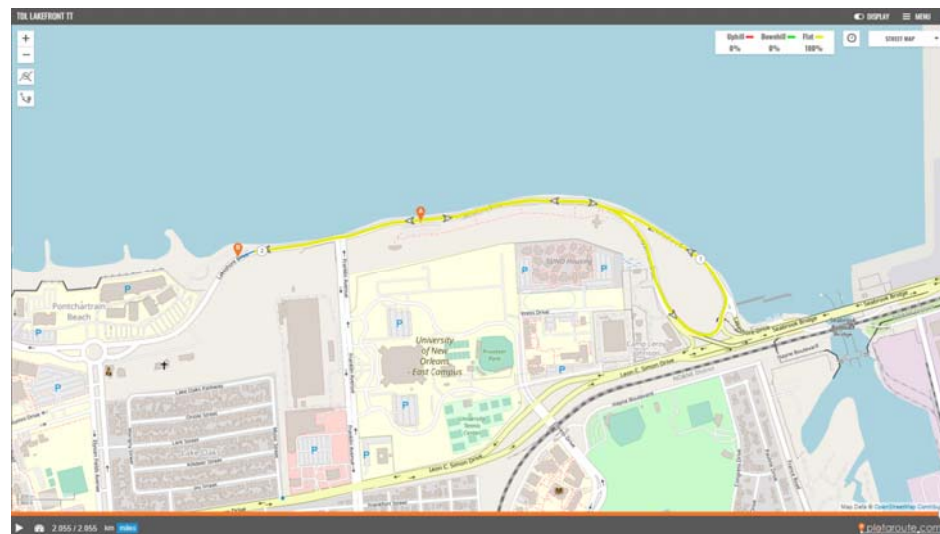
CIRCUIT RACE ROUTE

STAGE 2 INDIVIDUAL TIME TRIAL

TIME TRIAL RULES

- **START ORDER:** RIDERS WITHIN A CLASS START IN THE ORDER OF THEIR NUMBERS.
- **START TIMES:** Start times will be posted. Riders start at 30-second intervals. There will be gaps in the sequence of numbers between classes, so **PAY ATTENTION TO THE NUMBER CALLER!!**

- **REPORTING TO THE STARTER:** You must be in the start line three minutes (6 riders) before your start. If a rider misses his start, he must STOP at the starting line (one foot down), then he may be allowed to begin unless his start will interfere with that of another rider, in which case the referee will instruct him to wait. Timing begins from the original start time.
- **RESTARTS** will normally not be allowed. Riders suffering mishaps will be given the time of the slowest rider who finishes in his class.
- **DO NOT WARM UP ON THE COURSE** once the first rider has been called to the line.

TIME TRIAL COURSE**TIME TRIAL RESULTS**

Results through stage 2 will be available Sat. night on the NOBC and LAMBRA websites (www.lambra.org) as soon as they are ready, and posted near the start/finish of the criterium Sunday morning. Protests of stage and GC placings are acceptable up until the start of the next stage. Do not disturb the officials at the finish line; they will be unable to tell you your time. If you suffered a mishap and failed to cross the finish line, notify the officials at the start line. If you find a problem with the TT results, notify the chief referee prior to the start of the Criterium.

STAGE 3 Torres Park Criterium

CRITERIUM COURSE

Location: Start/finish near 3400 Dr. Meraux Blvd., Chalmette, LA. Parking access via 8201 W Judge Perez Dr, Chalmette, LA 70043.

Special Precautions: Pedestrians and possibly automobiles may need to cross the course at various points, so stay alert! In particular, there is always the possibility of pedestrians wandering onto the course. There are some cracks and seams in the concrete roads that require special attention and should be avoided. The course will be ridden clockwise, and numbers go on the right side. Although most of the course is good, there are a few cracks and holes in the concrete road surface where one section of concrete meets another, so be careful of those.

CRITERIUM RULES

- Riders are not permitted to warm up on the course until all riders from the previous race have finished.
- The FREE LAP RULE will be in effect. You MUST report to the pit in order to receive a free lap. The pit will be located in the area of the start line. Free laps are allowed only for mishaps as per USAC regulations. Riders suffering a mishap may not ride "against traffic" in order to get to the pit. NO FREE LAPS WILL BE GRANTED DURING THE FINAL 8 KILOMETERS OF THE RACE.
- All riders finish on the same lap as the leader.
- Lapped riders** may be pulled by the referee if they threaten to interfere with judging and/or the finish. Pulled riders will receive placings.
- Lapped riders** who are not pulled and allowed to continue, and are then caught by a **breakaway** from the field, may not lead [disqualification] the breakaway. Riders off the front of the field may not accept assistance from riders who have lost contact with the back of the field [disqualification for accepting such assistance]. Lapped riders not pulled may rejoin and race with the **field**.
- NUMBERS:** The large side number should be on RIGHT back, above the pockets. Back number on center lower back/pockets.

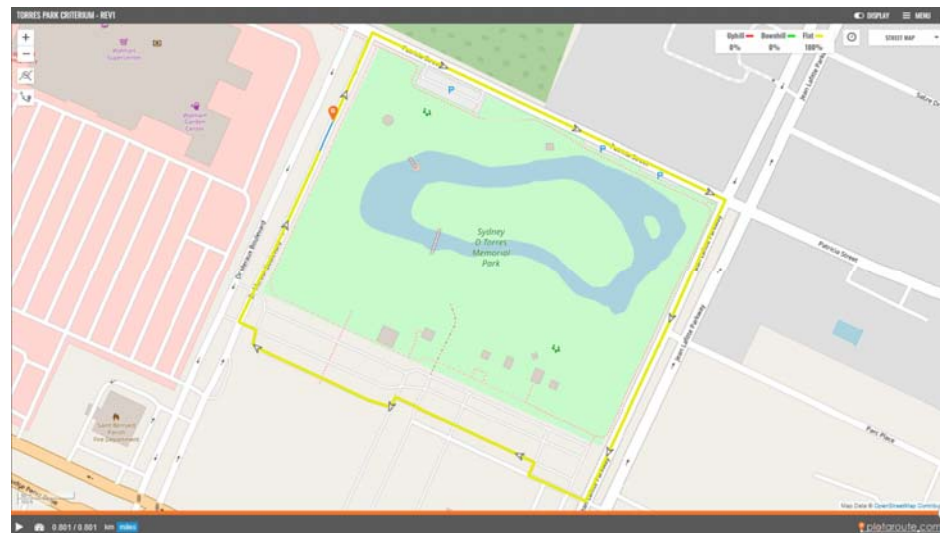
HOT SPOT

There will be a time bonus Hot Spot at the approximate **mid-point** of each race for *First-Third places only* worth 5, 3 and 2 points respectively. Hot Spots will be indicated by ringing of the bell.

CRITERIUM AND FINAL RESULTS and AWARDS

Results of each race will be posted in the area of the start/finish as soon as possible following that race. Protests of final results must be made within 15 minutes of posting. Awards will be presented as soon as possible following each race. Top 3 finishers should wear team jerseys for awards ceremony and podium photos. Complete final results will be posted to the NOBC website (neworleansbicycleclub.org) and the LAMBRA website. Final results are also uploaded to USA Cycling.
